

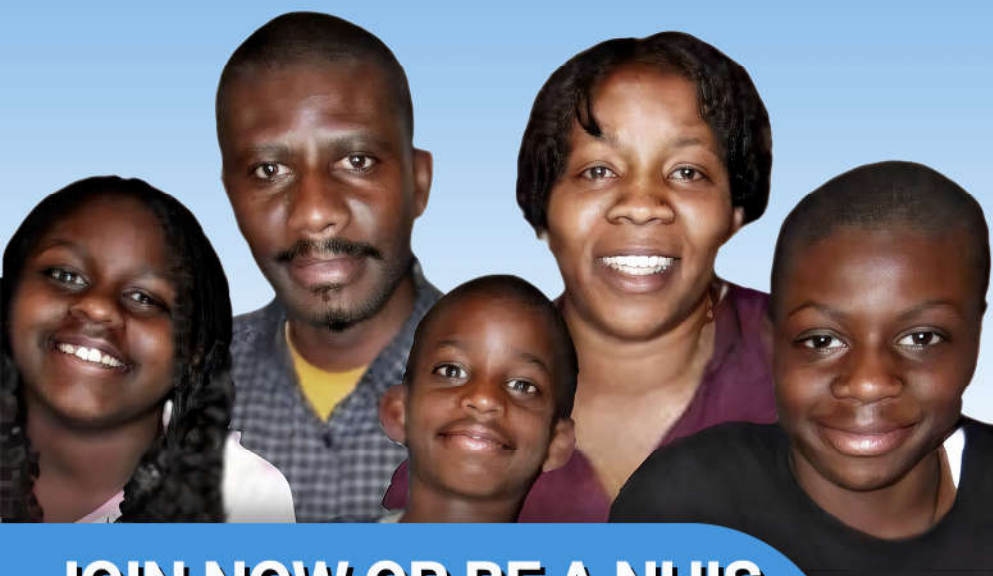

JOIN NOW OR BE A NHIS REPRESENTATIVE

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The NHIS is a national health insurance product introduced by the Government of Ghana to abolish the existing "cash and carry" system. The goal of NHIS is to promote basic health care for all. There are two major health insurance packages available:

PACKAGE 1: National Health Insurance for the Diaspora

PACKAGE 2: National Health Insurance for the Disabled Persons in Ghana

BENEFITS

The health insurance (for both packages) cost €25 for the whole year, and it is renewable on yearly basis.

Children below 18 years whose parents are insured can be registered for free.

The Health Insurance covers 95 % of diseases that afflict Ghanaians, which include malaria, breast and cervical cancer, surgical operations, maternal health care, emergency treatments, dental, etc

We need other individuals, groups and organizations to partner with us in implementing the project.

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PACKAGE 1: NHIS FOR DIASPORA

The National Health Insurance Scheme for the Diaspora provides you with the ability to care for yourself and the ones you love!

- Ghanaian migrants and their children can have access to basic health care service delivery while in Ghana.
- Ghanaian migrants can help provide quality health care services for family members (unable to pay for their own health insurance) living in Ghana.

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PACKAGE 2: NHIS FOR DISABLED PERSONS IN GHANA

The National Health Insurance Scheme for Disabled gives you the opportunity to help care for people in the country that you love!

- Disabled persons are often the most vulnerable in society because of physical impairment. Almost all of them lack the financial means to provide for their basic needs. With this package, Ghanaian migrants and non-Ghanaian institutions in Europe can support the vulnerable disabled and indigent in Ghana through the provision of basic health care.
